Missouri Girls Town Foundation, Inc.'s mission is to create a loving and stable environment for the care and treatment of our clients, so that each young woman may gain a new start in life. It is a mission that defines who we are, what we do, and why we can say confidently that Girls Town is a home "where caring counts."

Residential Treatment Program

In addition to the four residential houses, the campus includes a dining hall, recreation center, on-campus school, administrative building and counseling center. The environment emphasizes the normal process of growing up through group living, education, wholesome activities and work. Operating within state guidelines, Girls Town is licensed to serve Care Levels 3, 4 and Transitional Living. Individual, family and group counseling is provided on campus by licensed clinical social workers. Clients are seen weekly for group and individual therapy. In addition, there is a psychiatrist and registered nurse on staff at Girls Town to see that clients' needs are met.

Missouri Girls Town Foundation, Inc. is a residential treatment facility for girls ages 8-21. We provide 24/7 care 365 days of the year to our clients. We also provide individual and group therapy to our clients. In addition, they are seen by an on-site Psychiatrist. We are also responsible for meeting each client's physical and health needs.

Statistics for fiscal year starting July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009

- Total number of days of care provided to our clients = 17027 days
- Total number of individual hour long therapy sessions provided by a Licensed Social Worker = 1621
- Total number of individual 30 minute long therapy sessions provided by a Licensed Social Worker = 91
- Total number of 30 minute long group therapy sessions provided by a Licensed Social Worker = 3157
- Total number of 30 minute therapy sessions provided by on-site Psychiatrist = 253
- Total number of (non-Psychiatry) doctor visits made by our clients = 365
- Total number of dental visits made by our clients = 152
- Total number of eye exams provided to our clients = 80
- Total number of oral surgeries = 3

The objective of the above activities is to provide a safe and nurturing place for our clients to live, grow and heal. Besides providing basic needs, Missouri Girls Town provides services to improve each client's overall mental or physical health.

The long-term goal of each client is to help them to become productive adult citizens. Since the majority of our funding comes from the State of Missouri, one of our goals is that our clients will one day become tax-paying citizens.
